STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Fairfield & Skowhegan Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Fair
field & Skowhegan Railway Company, which were granted

by Chapter two hundred and sixty of the Private and Spe
cial Laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and seven,

and extended by Chapter eleven of the Private and Special

Laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and nine, are

hereby extended for two years from the approval of this

act, and the persons named in said act, their associates and

successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges

that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the

same manner and for the same purposes as provided in said
