STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Town of Merrill.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Township number six, range four, west from
2 the east line of the state, in the county of Aroostook, and
3 known as Merrill plantation, is hereby incorporated into a
4 town, by the name of Merrill, and the inhabitants of said
5 town are hereby vested with all the powers, privileges, im-
6 munities and liabilities of other towns.

Sect. 2. Any justice of the peace within the county of
2 Aroostook is hereby empowered to issue his warrant to
3 some inhabitant of said town, directing him to notify the in-
4 habitants thereof to meet at such time and place as he shall
5 appoint, to choose such officers as other towns are empow-
6 ered to choose at their annual town meeting.

Sect. 3. The town hereby created shall take the effects be-
2 longing to Merrill plantation, and shall also assume all the
3 obligations of said plantation.
