STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the Virginia Spring Water Company to take land for the purposes of its incorporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Virginia Spring Water Company, a cor2 poration duly organized and located at Rumford in the
3 County of Oxford and State of Maine is hereby authorized
4 and empowered to take, store and use the water from Blanch5 ard Brook, so called, in said Rumford, for domestic and fire
6 purposes in said Rumford. Said brook rises on land of
7 Rufus J. Virgin and flows through land of Waldo Pettingill
8 and George D. Bisbee and land of the heirs of Augustus
9 J. Knight and land of the heirs of George E. Blanchard to
10 the Androscoggin River.

And for constructing a dam and reservoir on said Blanch12 ard Brook for the proper storage and use of said water, and
13 for the protection of the water shed and sources of supply
14 of said brook, said Virginia Spring Water Company is here15 by authorized and empowered to take and hold land and
16 other real estate by purchase or otherwise.

Sect. 2. All locations made and all damages assessed for 2 the taking of any land or real estate as aforesaid shall be 3 made and assessed as provided in Chapter 164 of the Pub-4 lic Laws of 1905.
