STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT additional to Chapter seventeen of the Public Laws of
nineteen hundred and five, as amended by Chapter eighty-
nine of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, reg-
ulating the practices of veterinary surgery, medicine and
dentistry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section four of Chapter seventeen of the Pub-
lic Laws of nineteen hundred and five, as amended by Sec-
tion two of Chapter eighty-nine of the Public Laws of nine-
teen hundred and seven, is hereby amended by striking out
the first eight lines of said section and inserting the follow-
ing in place thereof: 'Any person who was engaged in the
practice of veterinary surgery, medicine or dentistry, or any

8 branch thereof in this state, on the twenty-second day of
9 February, nineteen hundred and five, may, on or before the
10 fifteenth day of September, nineteen hundred and eleven,
11 register his name and address with the State Board of Vet-
12 erinary Examiners and give proof to said board that he was
13 so in practice on said twenty-second day of February, nine-
14 teen hundred and five, and be entitled to all the rights and
15 privileges granted by said act as he would or might have
16 been if he had appeared before said board at the time stated
17 in Section four of the aforesaid act,' so that said section shall
18 read as follows:

'Sect. 4. Any person who was engaged in the practice of
20 veterinary surgery, medicine or dentistry, or any branch
21 thereof in this state, on the twenty-second day of Febru-
22 ary, nineteen hundred and five, may, on or before the fif-
23 teenth day of September, nineteen hundred and eleven, reg-
24 ister his name and address with the State Board of Vet-
25 erinary Examiners and give proof to said board that he was
26 so in practice on said twenty-second day of February, nine-
27 teen hundred and five, and be entitled to all the rights and
28 privileges granted by said act as he would or might have
29 been if he had appeared before said board at the time stated
30 in Section four of the aforesaid act. Any person shall be
31 regarded as practicing veterinary surgery, medicine, or
32 dentistry, or any branch thereof, within the meaning of this
33 act, who has publicly professed to be a veterinary surgeon,
34 or has prescribed for sick or injured animals and accepted

35 fees for such services, or has attached to his name the title
36 V. S. or Veterinary Surgeon, or any veterinary title ordi-
37 narily used. Nothing in this act shall be construed as pro-
38 hibiting any person residing in the State of Maine not reg-
39 istered from practicing veterinary surgery, medicine or
40 dentistry, or any branch thereof, and collecting reasonable
41 compensation for such service provided such person does not
42 attach to his name V. S. or Veterinary Surgeon, or any vet-
43 erinary title ordinarily used or advertised by card, sign or
44 otherwise.
