STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of the trustees of the University of Maine and the trustees of the State Normal Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Beginning with the first day of August, A. D.

2 1911, the trustees of the University of Maine and the Trus
3 tees of the State Normal Schools shall serve without pay,

4 excepting that said trustees shall be entitled to receive from

5 the State Treasury out of any money not otherwise ap
6 propriated, after proper audit or voucher, a sum sufficient

7 to defray any actual expenses incurred by them in connec
8 tion with their duties whether for travel or other expense.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are 2 repealed.
