STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to revive and extend the charter of the Lily Water
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Lily
2 Water Company which were granted by chapter one hun-
3 dred and two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
4 hundred and three, and extended by Chapter one hundred
5 and seventy-four of the Private and Special Laws of nine-
6 teen hundred and five, and by Chapter seventy-five of the
7 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and seven,
8 are hereby revived and extended for two years from the
9 approval of this act; and the persons named in said original
10 act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights,

11 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act,
12 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-
13 poses as specified in said act.
