IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the close time on caribou.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. The provisions of section eighteen of chapter
2 thirty-two of the revised statutes, as amended by section
3 one of chapter one hundred thirty-two of the public laws of
4 1905, relating to a close time on caribou, are hereby extended
5 for six years from October fifteenth, in the year of our Lord
6 one thousand nine hundred and eleven.
