STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to equity procedure.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In all causes in equity the court, by special order, may fix such time, or times, for filing answer, plea or demurrer, or replication, or for hearing of the cause, as justice may require.
