STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section ninety-seven of Chapter fifteen of
the Revised Statutes as amended relating to the appropriation
for the schooling in unorganized townships.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section ninety-seven of chapter fifteen of the
2 Revised Statutes as amended by chapter forty-five of the
3 Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five and by chapter
4 eighty-seven of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and
5 nine is hereby amended by striking out the word "fifteen"
6 in the second line thereof and substituting in place the word
7 'eighteen,' so that said section, when amended, shall read as
8 follows:

'Sect. 97. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions

10 of the three preceding sections, there is hereby appropriated
11 the sum of eighteen thousand dollars annually, which sum
12 shall be deducted and set aside therefor by the treasurer of
13 state from the annual school funds of the state.'
