STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT fixing the liability of a bank to its depositor for payment of forged or raised checks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No bank shall be liable to a depositor for the 2 payment by it of a forged or raised check unless within six 3 months after the return to the depositor of the voucher of 4 such payment, such depositor shall notify the bank that the 5 check so paid is forged or raised.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts in conflict with the pro-2 visions of this act are hereby repealed.
