STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section twelve of chapter two hundred of the Private and Special Laws of Maine of the year 1899, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Kennebec Water District."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section twelve of chapter two hundred of the
Private and Special Laws of 1899 is hereby amended by
adding in the last line of said section after the word taxation, 'except that real estate taken or held by said District
outside the limits and confines of same may be taxed where
the same is situate but nothing herein contained shall authorize the taxing of any part of the pipe line or any building

8 used in the operation of said water system,' so that said 9 section as amended will read:

'Sect. 12. The property of said district shall be exempt 11 from taxation, except that real estate taken or held by said 12 District outside the limits and confines of same may be 13 taxed where the same is situate but nothing herein contained 14 shall authorize the taxing of any part of the pipe line or any 15 building used in the operation of said water system.'
