AN ACT to amend Section six of Chapter three hundred forty-five of the Special Laws of 1909, relating to the creation of a board of trustees for the Sullivan-Franklin bridge, across the "Narrows," so-called.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section six of chapter three hundred forty-five of the Special Laws of 1909 is hereby amended by striking out the words "the last day of March, 1910, after," in the eighth and ninth lines thereof, so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 6. The following named citizens of Sullivan: C. H. Abbott, Will R. Harvey, H. H. Harvey, W. B. Blaisdell, Bradbury Smith, R. H. Springer, H. W. Dunbar and the

9 following named citizens of Franklin: Lincoln Bragdon, F.  
10 E. Blaisdell, S. S. Scammons, F. Bradbury, W. Bragdon.  
11 W. A. Havey and John Fickett shall be and are hereby con-  
12 stituted the first board of trustees authorized by this act, and  
13 shall hold office until such bridge shall be completed and  
14 opened to the public.'
