STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section six of Chapter three hundred fortyfive of the Special Laws of 1909, relating to the creation of a board of trustees for the Sullivan-Franklin bridge, across the "Narrows," so-called.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section six of chapter three hundred forty-five
2 of the Special Laws of 1909 is hereby amended by striking
3 out the words "the last day of March, 1910, after," in the
4 eighth and ninth lines thereof, so that said section as amend5 ed shall read as follows:

'Sect. 6. The following named citizens of Sullivan: C. H. 7 Abbott, Will R. Harvey, H. H. Harvey, W. B. Blaisdell, 8 Bradbury Smith, R. H. Springer, H. W. Dunbar and the

9 following named citizens of Franklin: Lincoln Bragdon, F. 10 E. Blaisdell, S. S. Scammons, F. Bradbury, W. Bragdon. II W. A. Havey and John Fickett shall be and are hereby constituted the first board of trustees authorized by this act, and 13 shall hold office until such bridge shall be completed and 14 opened to the public.'
