STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter thirty-eight of the Public Laws of 1905.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter thirty-eight of the Pub2 lic Laws of 1905 is hereby amended by inserting between the
3 words "shall" and "furnish" in the first line of said section
4 the following: 'By himself, his clerk, servant or agent,' so
5 that the section as amended shall read as follows:

'No person shall by himself, his clerk, servant or agent fur-7 nish oleomargarine in any hotel, restaurant or boarding 8 house, or at any lunch counter, to a guest or patron thereof, 9 instead of butter, without notifying said guest or patron that 10 the substance so furnished is not butter.'
