STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Central Maine Fair Company and repealing resolve in favor of the Central Maine Fair Association.

Resolved: Whereas, the Central Maine Fair Association 2 has by vote at a meeting duly called and held transferred all 3 of its interests, rights and privileges and property of every 4 name and nature to the Central Maine Fair Company of 5 Waterville, Maine, and whereas the said company proposes 6 to conduct an annual fair hereafter on the fair ground in 7 said Waterville, as heretofore conducted and carried on by 8 the said association and that the said association does not 9 propose to conduct any fair in the future, it is hereby re-10 solved that the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars be 11 and is hereby appropriated annually for the Central Maine 12 Fair Company, provided that the above named company 13 shall annually appropriate an equal amount to be paid in

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14 premium for stock, dairy and agricultural products. Said 15 company may draw said appropriation upon its vouchers 16 that such amount has been paid out for strictly stock, dairy 17 and agricultural purposes. Chapter 343 of the Resolves of 18 1909 is hereby repealed.
