## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Monmouth Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. D. D. Elliott, M. M. Elliott of Monmouth,

- 2 Maine, and Carl F. Getchell of Auburn, Maine, their asso-
- 3 ciates, successors and assigns are hereby made a corporation
- 4 under the name of the Monmouth Electric Company. The
- 5 purpose of said corporation shall be to make, generate, sell,
- 6 distribute and supply electricity in the town of Monmouth
- 7 in accordance with the general laws governing that business.
  - Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to construct,
- 2 own, maintain and operate manufacturies and works for
- 3 making, generating, distributing and supplying electricity in
- 4 said Monmouth and to make, generate, transmit, conduct and

- 5 distribute electricity in and throughout said town and to fur-6 nish, sell and supply the same for lighting buildings, public 7 highways, streets and ways and for heating, manufacturing, 8 mechanical and other purposes.
- Sect. 3. Said corporation is hereby authorized for the pur2 poses aforesaid subject to the laws regulating such uses, and
  3 with all the powers and privileges conferred on similar cor4 porations by law, to locate, construct and maintain its lines
  5 and pipes under or over land, public highways, ways, streets
  6 and bridges which now or hereafter may exist, with all nec7 essary erections, fixtures and appliances therefor, but in such
  8 manner as not to discommode or endanger the customary use
  9 of any such way.
- Sect. 4. Said corporation is further authorized to acquire 2 by purchase, lease or otherwise, plants, property, franchises, 3 rights, privileges and locations of other corporations or in-4 dividuals owning or controlling any water rights or privileges 5 and said corporations and individuals or any or all of them 6 are hereby authorized to lease, convey, transfer and assign 7 such property, franchises, rights, privileges and locations to 8 the said Monmouth Electric Company and after the acquisign 9 tion of such rights, privileges, franchises or locations the 10 aforesaid Monmouth Electric Company shall have, hold, en-11 joy and exercise the same for its own use and purpose as 12 though originally granted to it.
  - Sect. 5. Capital stock of said corporation shall not exceed

- 2 fifty thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred 3 dollars each.
  - Sect. 6. Said corporation may issue its bonds for the con-
- 2 struction of its work upon such rate and terms as it may deem
- 3 expedient not exceeding fifty thousand dollars and secure
- 4 the same by mortgage of the franchise and stock of said com-5 pany.
  - Sect. 7. The first incorporator named in this act may call
- 2 the first meeting of the corporation by mailing a written no-
- 3 tice signed by him, postpaid to each of the other incorpora-
- 4 tors seven days at least before the day of the meeting, naming
- 5 time, place and purpose of such meeting.
  - Sect. 8. This act shall take effect when approved.
