SENATE AMENDMENT A TO HOUSE DOCUMENT NO. 145.

Amend section one of House Document No. 145 by adding 2 after the word "Lubec" in the fifth line the words 'subject to 3 all the provisions of Chapter 244 of the Public Laws of 4 1909.' So that said section as amended shall read as follows: 'Section 1. The Lubec Sardine Company, a corporation or-6 ganized under the general laws of Maine and located at Lu-7 bec, is hereby authorized to generate, sell, distribute and sup-8 ply electricity for power, heating, lighting, manufacturing 9 and mechanical purposes in the town of Lubec subject to all 10 the provisions of Chapter 244 of the Public Laws of 1909.'
