STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of providing plans for school buildings.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of two hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred
3 and eleven and the sum of two hundred dollars for the year
4 nineteen hundred and twelve to provide for procuring archi-
5 tects' plans and specifications for school buildings by the
6 state superintendent of public schools, said plans and speci-
7 cations to be loaned to any superintending committee or
8 school building committee desiring to erect a new building as
9 provided for by chapter eighty-eight of the Public Laws of
10 nineteen hundred and nine.
