STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of sawdust or other mill waste into the outlet of Worthley pond, in the town of Peru, in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall put, or allow the same to be

- 2 done by any person within his employ, into the outlet of
- 3 Worthley pond, in the town of Peru, in the county of Ox-
- 4 ford, any mill waste, slabs, edgings, sawdust or any other
- 5 mill waste of a fibrous nature created in the manufacture of
- 6 any sawed or planed lumber, or to place or deposit the same
- 7 on the bank of said outlet of Worthley pond in such negli-
- 8 gent or carless manner that the same shall fall or be washed
- 9 into said outlet of Worthley pond, or with the intent that the

10 same shall fall or be washed into said outlet of Worthley
11 pond.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of 2 this act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than fifty 3 dollars nor more than one hundred dollars and costs of pros-
