STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section sixteen of chapter eighty-six of the
Revised Statutes, relating to sale of shares of the capital stock
of a corporation on execution.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section sixteen of chapter eighty-six of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 word "dwells" in the fourth line of said section the words
4 'otherwise by forwarding it to him by mail, postage paid,
5 whether within or without the state;' and by striking out
6 all of said section after the word "paper" in the tenth line,
7 so that said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 16. In selling said shares or interest, the officer hold-
9 ing the execution shall give notice in writing of the time

10 and place of sale to the debtor, by leaving it at his last and
11 usual place of abode, if within the county where the officer
12 dwells, otherwise by forwarding it to him by mail, postage
13 paid, whether within or without the state; and public notice
14 thereof by posting it in one or more public places in the town
15 where the sale is to be made, and in two adjoining towns if
16 there are so many, thirty days at least before the day of sale;
17 and shall publish an advertisement of the same import, nam-
18 ing the judgment debtor, for three weeks successively before
19 the day of sale, in some public newspaper printed in the
20 county, if any, if not, in the state paper.'
