STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Wiscasset Bridge.

*Resolved, That the sum of three thousand dollars be given
2 to the town of Wiscasset for the purpose of replanking the
3 Wiscasset bridge.*

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is a pile structure three thousand and fifty feet long. The bridge was opened in 1906. It cost about twenty thousand dollars, the State giving seventeen thousand dollars toward it. It is on the direct highway from Bath to Rockland, and from Augusta to Boothbay Harbor. It connects the shire town with a large section of Lincoln county.
