STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Island Falls.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred twenty-three dollars and ninety-nine cents be appropriated to reimburse the town of Island Falls for the expense of commitment and support of Mary Willett, an alien and State pauper, in the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital.
