RESOLVE in favor of the town of Woodstock.

*Resolved, That the sum of four hundred sixty-eight dollars  
2 and ninety-nine cents be appropriated to reimburse the town  
3 of Woodstock, in the county of Oxford and State of Maine,  
4 for money by it expended during the years 1908, 1909 and  
5 1910, in furnishing pauper supplies for Annie E. McLeod,  
6 the lawful wife of Don. B. McLeod, an alien and a State  
7 pauper, by reason of Sec. 1, Chap. 142, of the Public Laws  
8 of 1905.*
