STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of repairing highway in town of
Greenbush.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800)
2 be appropriated from any unexpended moneys in the State
3 treasury to aid in repairing that part of the highway in the
4 town of Greenbush in the county of Penobscot, known as
5 the Sand Hills, being three hills situated on the river road,
6 so called, and extending northerly from Woodsum Brook,
7 so called, about a mile and one-half or two miles in length
8 on said road.

Provided, that four hundred dollars be raised by said town
10 or otherwise, which together with the amount herein appro-
11 priated shall be sufficient to repair and complete said por-
12 tion of said highway within two years from the date of the
13 approval of this resolve without further special aid from the
14 State.

Said road shall be under the supervision of the State Highway Commissioner, and of the County Commissioners for said Penobscot County, in expending the above appropriation and in the making of said repairs.

All moneys under this resolve to be payable upon the completion of the repairs aforesaid upon the production of vouchers satisfactory to the Governor and Council.
