IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the provisions of chapter three hundred
and sixty-one of the Private and Special Laws of 1907, relat-
ing to fishing in the Fenderson brook, and its tributaries, in
the town of Parsonsfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The provisions of chapter three hundred and
2 sixty-one of the Private and Special Laws of 1907, relating
3 to fishing in the Fenderson brook, so-called, and its tribu-
4 taries, in the town of Parsonsfield, are hereby extended for
5 a term of two years from the time this act takes effect.

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
