STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the provisions of chapter three hundred and sixty-one of the Private and Special Laws of 1907, relating to fishing in the Fenderson brook, and its tributaries, in the town of Parsonsfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The provisions of chapter three hundred and
