STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter 117 of the Public
Laws of 1909, relating to the taking of white perch.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 117 of the public laws of 1909 is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end of said section, the
3 following: 'nor to white perch in inland waters of the coun-
4 ty of Washington. Said white perch, so taken from said
5 waters, may be shipped and sold within and without the
6 state, under regulations of the commissioners of inland fish
7 and game,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as
8 follows:

'Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any one person in any
10 one day to take, catch or kill, or have in possession more

11 than twenty pounds of white perch; it shall also be unlawful
12 for any transportation company to accept for transportation
13 or to transport more than twenty pounds of white perch
14 in one day as the property of any one person. This section
15 shall not apply to white perch in tide waters, nor to white
16 perch in inland waters of the county of Washington. Said
17 white perch, so taken from said waters, may be shipped and
18 sold within and without the state, under regulations of the
19 commissioners of inland fish and game.'
