STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the catching or taking of eels in Saint Georges River, in Warren, in the county of Knox, in any other way or manner than by hook and line or with spears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The catching or taking of eels in Saint Georges
2 river, in Warren, in the county of Knox, is hereby prohib3 ited, except by hook and line or with spears.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of five dollars and costs for each 3 offense.
