STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT giving the Rumford Falls Village Corporation ad-
ditional powers to raise money.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Rumford Falls Village Corporation, lo-
2 cated in Rumford, Maine, is hereby authorized at any legal
3 meeting called and held for said purpose or purposes to
4 raise and appropriate money for the purpose of acquiring
5 by purchase land for parks or playgrounds within its limits,
6 also for the purpose of aiding in building and caring for
7 a hospital, known as the Rumford General Hospital. The
8 corporation is also authorized to take title to land so pur-
9 chased also acquired by gift.
