STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the Board of Overseers of the Poor of
the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Overseers of the Poor and Workhouse
2 shall consist of ten persons and the Chairman of the Board
3 of Aldermen of the said City shall be Chairman of the
4 Overseers of the Poor and Workhouse ex officio.

Sect. 2. The other nine persons of the Overseers of the
2 Poor and Workhouse shall be elected at the first election
3 of subordinate officers, in Portland, on the second Mon-
4 day of December, three of whom shall be elected for three
5 years each year after the passage of this Act.

Sect. 3. That as the terms of office of the present mem-

2 bers of the Overseers of the Poor and Workhouse ex-
3 pire, their successors shall be selected from the wards not
4 represented on the said Overseers in the following manner:
5 In 1911 one member shall be elected for three years; in
6 1912 four members shall be elected, three for three years
7 and one for two years; in 1913 four members shall be
8 elected, three for three years, and one for one year, and
9 thereafter the said members of the Board of Overseers shall
10 be selected as provided in Section 2, making the Board nine
11 members besides the Chairman.

Sect. 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the
2 provisions herein contained are hereby repealed.
