RESOLVE, in favor of the Holy Innocents Home for Infants
in the city of Portland.

Resolved: That there be and is hereby appropriated the
2 sum of four thousand (\$4,000) dollars to be paid to the Holy
3 Innocents Home of Portland, for the use of the said institu-
4 tion; two thousand (\$2,000) dollars to be appropriated for
5 the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred
6 eleven, (1911) and two thousand (\$2,000) dollars to be ap-
7 propriated for the use of the institution for the year nine-
8 teen hundred twelve, (1912) for maintenance.
