STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of St. Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Asylum
of Portland.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the
2 sum of four thousand (4,000) dollars to be paid to the St.
3 Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Asylum of Portland, for the
4 use of the said institution; two thousand (2,000) dollars to
5 be appropriated for the use of said institution for the year
6 nineteen hundred eleven, (1911), and two thousand (2,000)
7 dollars to be appropriated for the use of the said institution
8 for the year nineteen hundred twelve, (1912), for main-
9 tenance.
