STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, constituting the state treasurer the trustee of the
Isaac Sanford legacy for the deaf, dumb and blind, and pro-
viding for the expenditure of the interest thereon.

Resolved: That the treasurer of the State of Maine and
2 his successor in office be and he hereby is the trustee under
3 the will of Isaac Sanford to keep the legacy of six hundred
4 dollars as provided in said will.

And be it further Resolved: That the state shall set apart
6 annually a sum equal to six per centum interest on said leg-
7 acy, and shall pay such interest, under the direction of the
8 Governor and Council, as aid toward the education of deaf,
9 dumb and blind natives of Maine, in institutions established
10 for the education of such persons, provided that if in future
11 it is deemed inadvisable to continue the payment of such in-
12 terest, the principal sum and any accrued interest shall be
13 expended as the Governor and Council shall order.
