STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the assessment of taxes in organized plantations, included in the Maine Forestry District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The treasurer of state shall annually send his
2 warrant, together with a copy of the assessment of taxes
3 upon the organized plantations in the Maine Forestry Dis-
4 trict, directed to the municipal officers of said plantations,
5 requiring them respectively to assess, in dollars and cents;
6 the sum so charged, according to the provisions of the law
7 for the assessment of such taxes, and to add to the amount
8 of such tax the amount of state, county and plantation taxes,
9 to be by them assessed in each plantation respectively.
