STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Frank H. Sterling.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of six hundred and sixty-three dollars and forty-five 3 cents to be paid to Frank H. Sterling of Caratunk, to be by 4 him paid to Alanson McKeown and forty others, as per list 5 accompanying this resolve as a part of the statement of 6 facts.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

These men have never been paid for their work, as their claims were not before the Legislature of 1909 to go along with the general deficiency bill for forest fires in the fall of 1908.

The accompanying bill, or list of names of those to whom various amounts are due, is approved by Mr. Sterling as Chief Forest Fire Warden, and duly sworn to by him.

STATEMENT OF FACTS AS TO NEW DRAFT.

The original resolve, by a clerical mistake, was erroneous as to the amount of money involved.
