STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of roads in Indian Township.

Resolved: That the sum of four hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated for the construction and repair of the
3 road and bridges in Indian Township, Washington County,
4 for the year nineteen hundred and eleven and four hundred
5 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve. Each of
6 the above appropriations shall be expended in each year as
7 follows: At the direction of the State Commissioner of
8 Highways.
