STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine Children's Home Society, of Augusta.

Resolved: That there be and is hereby appropriated the 2 sum of one thousand dollars for the use of the Maine Chil-3 dren's Home Society of Augusta, for the year nineteen hun-4 dred and eleven, and one thousand dollars for the year nine-5 teen hundred and twelve, both sums for maintenance. Should 6 there be any unexpended balance of said appropriation for 7 a particular year, such balance shall not lapse, but may be 8 expended in the year next succeeding.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Maine Children's Home Society receives and cares for neglected children in its home at Augusta, and finds homes for such children. It has received assistance from the state for the work for a number of years past.
