STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Children's Heart Work Society of Maine.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of three hundred dollars to be paid to the Children's 3 Heart Work Society of Maine for the use of said society

- 4 for the year one thousand nine hundred and eleven and three
- 5 hundred dollars for the use of said society for the year one
- 6 thousand nine hundred and twelve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Children's Heart Work Society secures homes for neglected and ill-treated children. It was aided in the carrying on of its work by the last Legislature, and the amount recommended by the accompanying resolve is in continuation of the assistance heretofore rendered by the state.
