STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT regulating the use of rights and locations in public streets.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No corporation granted a right or location in 2 the streets of Augusta shall abandon or discontinue the use

- 3 of a portion of said location without the consent of the mu-
- 4 nicipal officers.
- Sect. 2. Any part of a location granted as in Section one
- 2 of this act which has been discontinued or abandoned with-
- 3 out the consent of the municipal officers shall forthwith be
- 4 resumed and restored to the use for which such location was
- 5 granted upon order of the municipal officers.
 - Sect. 3. To enforce the provisions of this act injunction

- 2 proceedings upon petition of the municipal officers shall lie
- 3 to restrain the partial use of any location or right until com-
- 4 pliance with the order set forth in Section two of this act.
