STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in aid of Trull Hospital Aid Association.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of one thousand dollars to be paid to the Trull Hospi-3 tal Aid Association, a corporation at Biddeford, York Coun-4 ty, Maine, five hundred dollars of said sum to be for the use 5 of said corporation for the year nineteen hundred and eleven 6 and five hundred dollars to be for the use of said corpora-7 tion for the year nineteen hundred and twelve. Said sums 8 to be used by said corporation in the charitable work in 9 which it is engaged in accordance with its articles of incorporation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Trull Hospital Aid Association of Biddeford is doing a large charitable work in connection with the Trull Hospital, located in Biddeford. Aid was given the Association for assistance in its work by the Legislature two years ago.
