STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Reciprocity with Canada.

Whereas, we recognize the benefit to the welfare of the people of the United States that will accrue from more liberal trade relations with Canada, and

Whereas, these measures are encouraged and the principles of more liberal trade laws are advocated by so-called reciprocity, and

Whereas, the President of the United States recognizing the demand for more cordial trade relations with Canada has advocated a measure of reciprocity, which is a beginning of more liberal laws and of ultimate benefit to this people, therefore,

Resolved, That we request our senators and representatives
2 in Congress to use their influence for the adoption of such

3 measures as will bring about fair, reciprocal relations be-
4 tween Canada and the United States.

Resolved, That the Secretary of State be instructed to for-
6 ward a copy of this resolution to the senators and repre-
7 sentatives in Congress from the State of Maine.
