STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE providing for carrying on the work of the State Survey Commission.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated for 2 carrying on the work of the State Survey Commission the 3 sum of ten thousand dollars for the year 1911 and a like 4 sum for the year 1912, to be expended under the provisions 5 of act approved March 23, 1905, chapter 144.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This is the regular annual appropriation for carrying on the Topographic, Hydrographic, and Geologic Survey of the State. A detailed report of the work of the past two years is in the hands of the Legislature.

By contract with the United States Government the Government appropriated an amount equal to that appropriated by the State and the work is done in co-operation.
