STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE authorizing the Land Agent to sell certain public
lots in Cary Plantation in Aroostook County.

Resolved, That the Land Agent is hereby authorized to
2 sell and convey to actual settlers thereon certain lands in
3 Cary plantation in Aroostook county, constituting part of
4 the school lots of said plantation, if he deems advisable, for
5 such price per acre and on such terms of payment as he
6 may deem advantageous; provided, that in making sales of
7 said lands the legal and equitable rights of persons claiming
8 under said settlers shall be considered and preserved; and
9 provided, also, that the proceeds of any sales shall be added
10 to the school fund of said plantation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

For a number of years certain portions of the public or school lands of Cary Plantation have been occupied by parties who took possession of the land, cleared and farmed portions of the same and have erected buildings thereon. Said parties have paid no taxes on their property to the plantation, or rent to the State. It is in order to properly adjust these matters, protecting whatever rights said settlers may have and securing the equity of the State, acting as custodian of such lands, for the plantation, that this resolve is asked.
