STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to amend and unify the laws regulating the sale of agricultural seeds, commercial feeding stuffs, commercial fertilizers, drugs, foods, fungicides and insecticides.

Amendments presented by Mr. Hersey of Houlton.

Amend Section 6 (House No. 263, page 5, lines 9 and 10) by striking out the clause "The specific name of each ingredient used in its manufacture."

Amend Section 10 (House No. 263, page 7, line 7) by striking out the words "or commercial fertilizers."

Amend Section 12, In case of foods, 3rd (House No. 263, page 14, line 59) by adding: 'Provided, however, that reasonable variations shall be permitted and that tolerances shall be established by rules and regulations made in accordance with the provisions of this act.'
