## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the removal of the bodies of deceased persons from the old cemetery in the Plantation of Elliottsville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Greenville Light & Power Company is hereby
2 empowered to authorize the assessors of the plantation of
3 Elliottsville to take up from the old cemetery in the planta4 tion of Elliottsville near the west bank of Wilson River the
5 bodies and remains of all deceased persons buried therein,
6 and all head stones and markers at the graves therein, and
7 remove said bodies and remains to a new cemetery to be
8 selected by said assessors and there decently inter the same,

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9 and properly reset such head stones and markers over such 10 dead bodies and remains. Said assessors are within thirty 11 days after being requested in writing by said Greenville 12 Light and Power Company to select the place for said new 13 cemetery. If said assessors fail to locate said new ceme-14 tery and fix the bounds thereof within said thirty days, then 15 the directors of said Greenville Light and Power Company 16 are authorized to locate said cemetery in such place as will 17 be suitable and most convenient for all of the inhabitants of 18 said plantation. All of the expenses incurred in procuring 19 the land necessary for said new cemetery in clearing and 20 fitting the ground and in fencing said cemetery and in the 21 taking up and removal of all of the remains of all of the de-22 ceased persons, and in the removal of said head stones and 23 markers, and the interment of said remains and resetting of 24 said head stones and markers shall be paid by the Greenville 25 Light and Power Company.

No claim shall be made against said Greenville Light and 27 Power Company for not complying with the terms herein 28 set out unless the same is made within sixty days after the 29 Greenville Light and Power Company gives said assessors 30 written notice that it has performed its duties under this 31 act.
