STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVED, in favor of the Counties of Kennebec and
Somerset.

Resolved, that the sum of four hundred dollars to be paid
2 to the County of Kennebec, and the sum of one hundred and
3 eighty-one dollars and twenty-five cents to be paid to the
4 county of Somerset be, and is hereby appropriated to reim-
5 burse said counties on account of moneys paid by said
6 counties for interest on balances over-due American Bridge
7 Company of New York, in construction of the Hinckley
8 bridge, as authorized by chapter 231 of the Resolves of 1909.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Resolves, Chap. 231 of 1909 Authorized building of bridge.

Total	\$25 000	\$50 000

Contract for building was made with Kennebec & Somerset Counties. Vouchers under the resolve were seasonably filed with State Auditor and approved by him.

Demand for payment was duly made on the State.

Both counties and the three towns paid full amount due from them promptly and before January 1910.

The two counties paid the amount for interest as set out in the resolve, and as shown on copy of receipt and letter attached.
