STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Albion.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred and fifty-one 2 dollars be, and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the 3 treasurer of the town of Albion for said town, the same 4 being for moneys paid by said town for the expense of sup-5 porting Henrietta Lewis, Ernest Stratton and Nellie Knight, 6 insane persons unable to support themselves and who had 7 no relatives of sufficient ability legally bound to support 8 them.
