STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE for the Appointment of Delegates to the Confer-
ences of the International Tax Association.

Resolved, That the Governor, by and with the consent of
2 the Council, be and hereby is authorized and empowered to
3 appoint not more than three delegates to represent the State
4 of Maine at any conferences of the International Tax Asso-
5 ciation which may be held during the years nineteen hun-
6 dred and eleven and nineteen hundred and twelve. Such
7 delegates shall serve without compensation, but their actual
8 expenses, as allowed by the Governor and Council, shall be
9 paid from the state treasury.
