RESOLVE in favor of John A. McDonald.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred thirty-one dollars to be paid to John
3 A. McDonald of Augusta, as balance due for wages as fire-
4 man at the State House, from October 1st, 1899, to January
5 1st, 1902.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

John A. McDonald was fireman during the period above mentioned, at a wage fixed at seventy-five dollars a month. During the twenty-seven months he earned three thousand and twenty dollars, and was paid the sum of twenty-four hundred and eighty-nine dollars. The amount asked for in the above resolve is the difference between the wages paid and the wages earned and due Mr. McDonald for the period in the resolve.
