STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the Solemnization of Marriages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The governor, with the advice and consent of
2 the council, may appoint women, otherwise eligible under
3 the constitution, to solemnize marriages.

Sect. 2. Women so appointed shall have the same rights
2 and obligations in the solemnization of marriages as are had
3 by justices of the peace.
